RESEARCH CONSULTATION

You need to book an appointment to get literature review assistance or discuss your research-specific information needs in a one-on-one research consultation with librarians.

SYSTEMATIC REVIEWS

Librarians can help with numerous steps throughout the planning, conducting, and reporting phases of your systematic review. With our specialized knowledge of the systematic review process, we can save you time and avoid confusion by providing guidance on the systematic review process and guide you through the process, as well as actively helping to develop and refine your topic, create systematic literature searches of all of the relevant databases, search the grey literature etc.

OPEN ACCESS IMAGES

Finding images online and using them properly can be difficult. Librarians will help you access different types of images which are available for public use, explain the different types of licensing, and show you how to correctly attribute any images you may use.

WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH TOPICS

The Library conducts workshops on various research topics in collaboration with publishers. These workshops are helpful for faculty, students and researchers to understand and learn international best practices.

DIGITAL TOOLS TO SUPPORT YOUR RESEARCH

Librarians will help with providing a list of the digital tools available to support research. Tools include the following:

REFERENCE MANAGEMENT

Reference management software ENDNOTE is available on the library computers, the software can be installed on faculty and resident's laptops subjected to the availability of the licenses.

ENDNOTE can be used to import references from multiple databases; organize and manage references; and format bibliographies and manuscripts.

DATABASES TRAINING

The library regularly conducts database training sessions in collaboration with several database providers. These sessions cover various topics including:

- To learn the features available on the database platform
- How to find information using the search platform
- To learn about the subject areas the database cover and many more.

STATISTICAL ANALYSIS SOFTWARE

The University provides access to the statistical analysis software like SPSS for faculty and students to use it for their research work. The use of this software may address entire analytical process:

- Planning
- Data collection
- Analysis
- Reporting
- Deployment
