Interesting cases



. 18-month female patient presented with severe urticarial rash with associated swelling of mucous membranes but no airway involvement and was admitted and started on loratadine and prednisolone



. 10-year old female patient with known case of laryngomalacia presented with episodes of interrupted breathing throughout the day. Additionally, has history of cerebral palsy, adenolectomy, and ventilation tubes in ears. Doctor performed a laryngoscopy and recommended a supraglottoplasty.



. 27-day old male presented to the ED with cough, runny nose, and lethargy for 5 days. Blood gas revealed evidence of combined type respiratory failure. Investigations done revealed bacteremia with Methicillin Resistant Staphylococcus Epidermidis, Acute Bronchiolitis with Rhinovirus confirmed on respiratory pathogen panel, and UTI with Citrobacter Freundii grown on culture. Patient initiated on Meropenem and symptomatic management
